Copy and paste the coupon code, or type in manually using **Caps and numbers 1 - 9**. There are no zeroes in the code. If it looks like a zero it's Letter O.

To prepare for the riding portion of our course you must successfully complete an online eCourse. Find the eCourse online at <http://www.msf-usa.org>. Select **MSF Digital**→**Basic eCourse**→**Enroll Now**→ complete the registration using the coupon code above.

You may not be able to enter the coupon code until you complete page 1 and select, "Enroll Student." Page 2 should allow you to enter the coupon code. Then select "complete registration." Page 2 looks like this:

Temporary enrollee successfully added. Temporary enrollees' seat's are not reserved until the enrollment process is complete. Click 'Complete Registration' to continue the enrollment process or fill out the form again and Click 'Add Additional Student' to add additional temporary enrollees.

After successfully completing the eCourse, print a copy of your certificate, showing the completion ID code and date within 30 days of your first class, and bring it with you to class. You will not be permitted to ride unless you have provided proof of successful completion of the eCourse.

The eCourse can only be taken on a desktop or laptop computer using either Internet Explorer 10, Firefox 3.5, Google Chrome, or Safari 2.0. JavaScript must be enabled. Once you have logged in and created your own personal password, you can log out and log in as often as needed. It takes about 3 hours to complete the eCourse.

The eCourse covers all of the material in the Basic Rider Course Rider Handbook [Handbook] and will prepare you for your first riding session. While you do not need the Handbook to complete the eCourse, it may help as an extra reference.
